

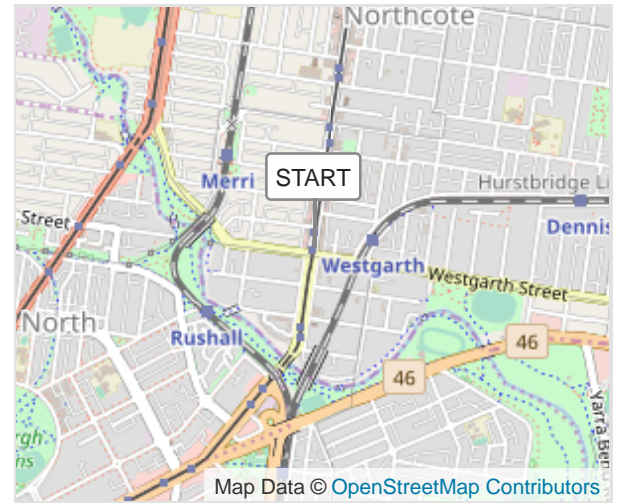


# Keep Moving Walk 3: Merri Creek Circuit

## NOTES

This is a very pleasant 2km walk for a sunny morning, taking in quiet residential streets and paths along the Merri Creek.

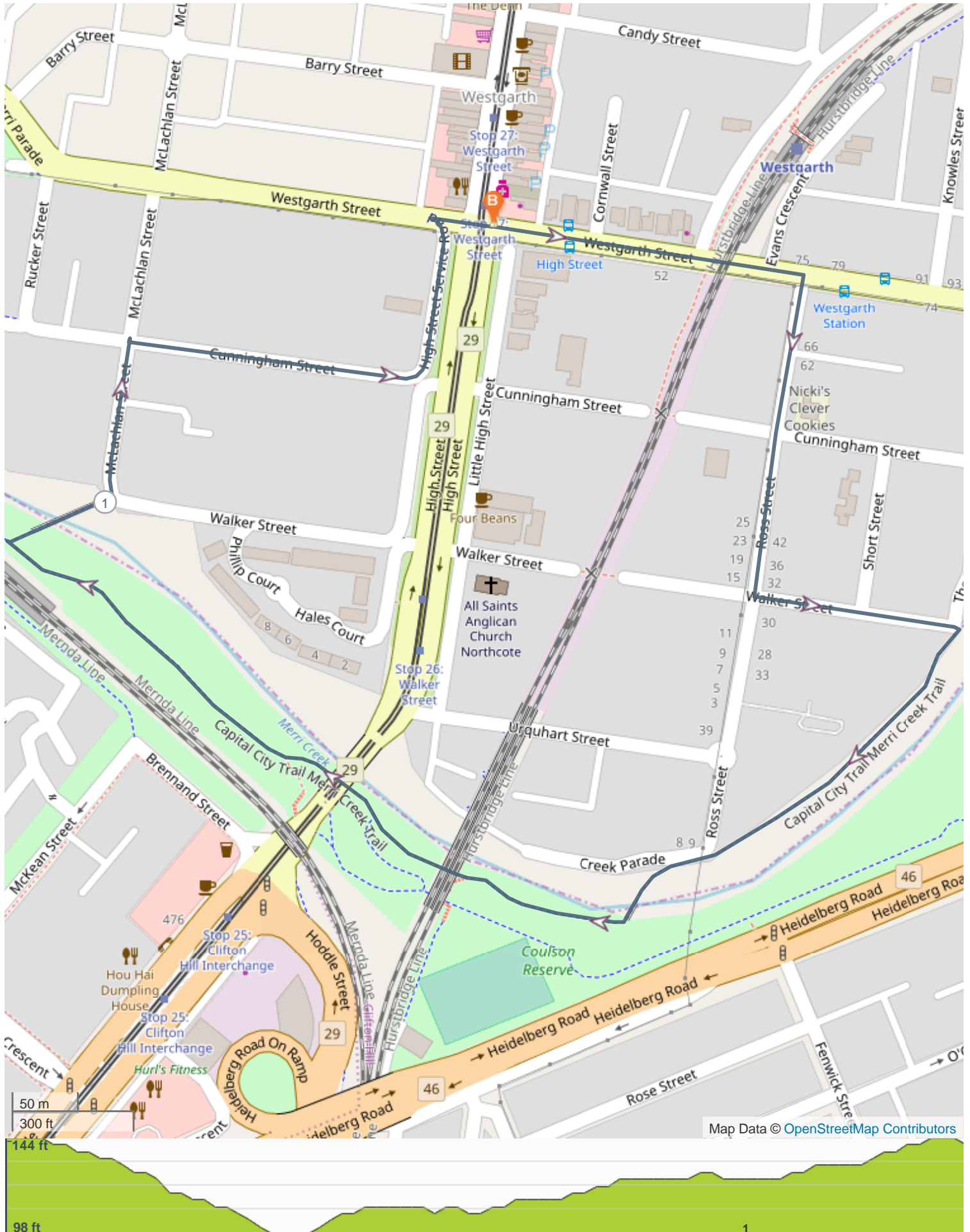
From the start point at the intersection of High St and Westgarth St, head east across the railway crossing, and turn right into Ross St. Walk down Ross St, turn left into Walker St. At the bend at the end of that street, turn sharp right onto the walking track, which heads down along the side of Merri Creek.

This path comes to the edge of the creek, and crosses a sparkling section of the creek over a small footbridge.

Continue along the trail on the far side of the creek, passing underneath the railway bridge and then the High Street bridge. There are paths here that take you up to High St, but if you continue on alongside the creek the trail leads up to a high footbridge over the creek adjacent to Rushall Station.

Cross over the creek on the footbridge, and turn left into McLachlan St, then right into Cunningham St. This brings you back to High St, close to the starting point at the intersection with Westgarth St.

6	0.778	↗	Turn slight right onto Capital City Trail Merri Creek Trail
7	0.951	↖	Turn left onto Merri Creek Trail
8	0.952	↖	Turn left onto McLachlan Street
9	1.078	➤	Turn left onto Cunningham Street
10	1.080	➤	Keep left onto Cunningham Street
11	1.289	↘	Turn sharp right onto Westgarth Street, 38
